



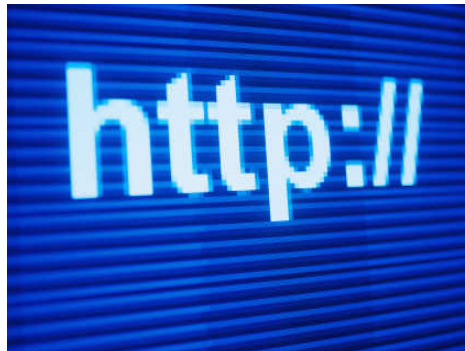

## New Activities @ The Village.

### Horse Therapy:

The Village Centre will resume sessions for our students here at the Village in 'Horse Therapy'. This therapy has shown increased benefits for *all* children with special educational needs, particularly those with autism and social communication difficulties. Benefits include; self esteem, communication language, and developing relationships.

The programme encourages the children to develop a relationship with the horse, become responsible for their horse and develop independence.

### Saturday Social Skills Club:

This is a group based program where students of different ages will come together to get assistance in learning appropriate social skills alongside literacy and numeracy for everyday life. They will also have the opportunity to express themselves through arts and crafts, incorporating cooking as well as creative sessions to encourage artistic talents through clay modeling, painting and craft activities. Trips and outings are also integrated into the programme to allow the children the opportunity to practice social and life skills in a practical way.
